

# GENERAL RULES FOR MARKET PROJECTS-2018

1. All exhibitors must be bona fide 4-H or FFA members between the age of eight and in the third grade and nineteen years of age not yet graduated from high school from the following districts: Arp, Bullard, Chapel Hill, Lindale, Troup, Tyler, Whitehouse, and Winona.
2. The Smith County Youth Exposition Show will comply with all requirements of H.B. 72 concerning eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities. Failure of a student to comply with this requirement will result in disqualification from participating in any part of the Smith County Youth Exposition. Scholastic ineligibility by school prohibits participation by students or animal.
3. Exhibitors for animals in the market swine, lamb, and goat shows must retain ownership of the animal by December 1, 2017. All animals, excluding poultry and rabbits, must be state validated, and/or in a permanent position so that validation can be performed by December 1. Roaster and Broiler entry forms should be completed and returned by December 15, 2017. Market Rabbit ownership should be no later than 3 weeks before the show date. Entry forms should be completed and returned to the Smith County Youth Exposition Show by the designated date.
4. Exhibitors will be limited to the sale of two lots; exhibitors may only sell one from each division. ONLY BLUE RIBBON PROJECTS WILL BE SOLD!
5. A 5% commission on all projects will be deducted from checks of projects floored or sold at auction. From this money, one picture will be bought for the buyer. If exhibitors want additional pictures, they will make arrangements with the photographer to pay for them. Also, when necessary, additional money will be deducted from checks to compensate for animal shrink.
6. Animal disposition options at the sale are as follows: (Buyers Options on Animals Purchased)
  - I will donate the market animal VALUE project back to the SCYE scholarship fund.
  - I will take the floor amount as a credit to my bill.
  - STUDENT WILL RECEIVE ENTIRE BID.
7. Friday immediately following the sale will be clean up at the show grounds. All exhibitors are expected to be present at cleanup.
8. Within each market animal division, a minimum of 70% of the exhibitor RIBBONS present will be sold. The judge will determine the sale order. NO PROJECT DEEMED RED RIBBON BY THE JUDGE SHALL BE SOLD.
9. The exhibitor must be present to sale their animal at SCYE. No exceptions unless approved by the SCYE Executive Board officers prior to the sale. Emergency situations will be considered separate of this rule.
