

SPECIES SPECIFIC RULES

Steer Division

1. All steers must be slick-shorn (1/4 inch) except tail.
2. Steers will be weighed prior to show. A minimum of 1000 pounds will be required
3. *All steers must be State validated through Smith County.*

Swine Division

1. Only barrows will be shown for the market swine show.
2. Barrows at weigh-in will have a tolerance weight of + or – ten pounds. Weight will be a minimum of 200 pounds and no more than 280 pounds. Classes will be determined after weigh-in.
3. *All barrows must be State validated through Smith County.*

Sheep Division

1. Only wether lambs will be allowed.
2. Lambs at weigh-in will have to weigh a minimum of 85 pounds.
3. All lambs must be slick-sheared.
4. *All sheep must be State Validated through Smith County.*

Goat Division

1. Only wether goats will be allowed.
2. Tipped-horned animals will be allowed to show (dime-sized or larger).
3. All goats must be slick shorn.
4. *All Goats must be State validated through Smith County.*

Rabbit Division

1. A pen shall consist of 3 rabbits of the same breed, age, and weight.
2. Rabbits should not be more than 12 weeks old.
3. Rabbits should weigh 3.5 to 5.5 pounds each.

Roaster Division

1. A pen shall consist of one bird.
2. All chicks will be ordered through the Smith County Youth Expo, Inc.

Showmanship Division

1. In order to participate in showmanship, a student must have exhibited an animal in the species show in which they wish to participate in the showmanship competition.

Heifer Division

1. All heifers must be registered and shown within that breed. Any classification questions or issues must be addressed with show superintendent prior to show.

*****Minimum and maximum weights in any division may be adjusted by show superintendent or executive board due to timing of show and other extenuating circumstances. *****
